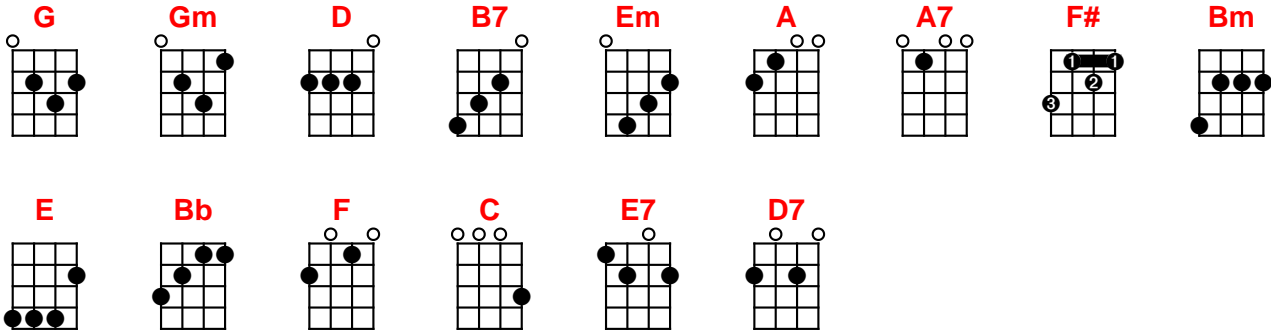


# I Hold Your Hand in Mine
