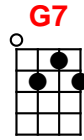
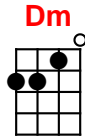
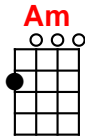
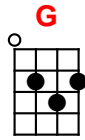
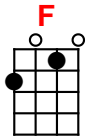
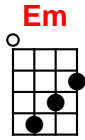
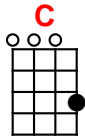


Somewhere Only We Know
