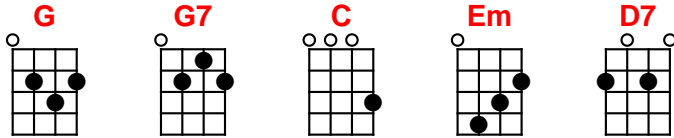


Will The Circle Be Unbroken
