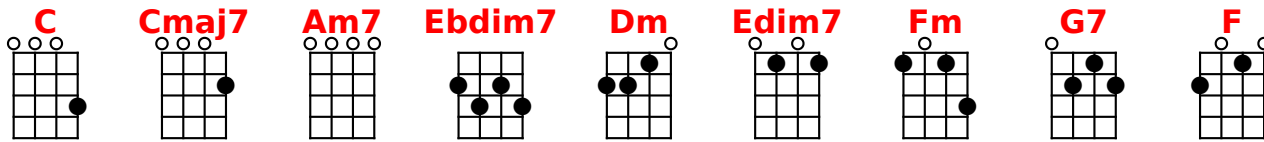


Smile (Key of C)

Intro: Slow strum pattern on **[C]** x4

[C] Smile, though your heart is aching
[Cmaj7] Smile, even though it's breaking. **[Am7]**
When there are **[Ebdim7]** clouds in the **[Dm]** sky,
[Edim7] you'll get by.

If you **[Dm]** smile through your fear and sorrow
[Fm] Smile, and maybe tomorrow
[C] You'll see the sun come shining
[Dm] through for **[G7]** you.

[C] Light up your face with gladness,
[Cmaj7] Hide every trace of sadness.
[Am7] Although a **[Ebdim7]** tear
May be **[Dm]** ever so **[Edim7]** near,

That's the **[Dm]** time you must keep on trying
[Fm] Smile, what's the use of crying?
[C] You'll find that **[Am7]** life is still worth-**[Dm]**while--
If **[G7]** you'll just **[C]** smile.

Solo: **[C]** Light up your face with gladness,
[Cmaj7] Hide every trace of sadness.
[Am7] Although a **[Ebdim7]** tear
May be **[Dm]** ever so **[Edim7]** near,

That's the **[Dm]** time you must keep on trying
[Fm] Smile, what's the use of crying?
[C] You'll find that **[Am7]** life is still worth-**[Dm]**while-
(slower) If **[G7]** you'll just **[C]** smile. **[F] [G7] [Cmaj7]** (hold)
