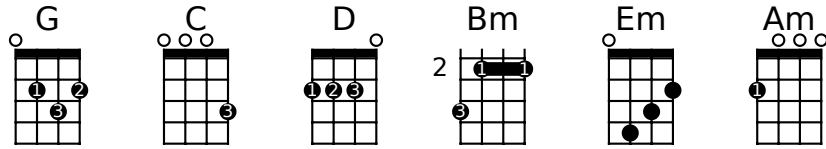


# Last Night I Had the Strangest Dream
