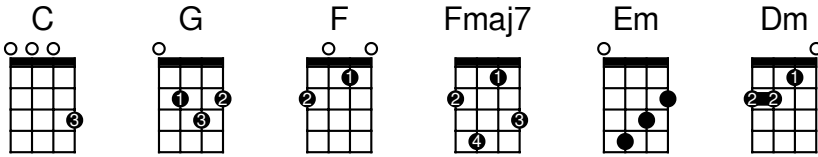


Do You Remember
