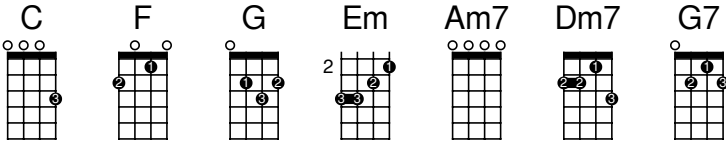


# Blue Boat Home
