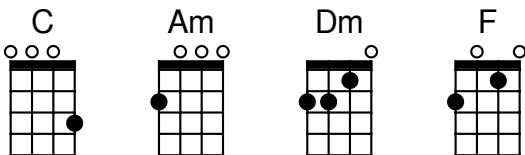


# Aragon Mill
