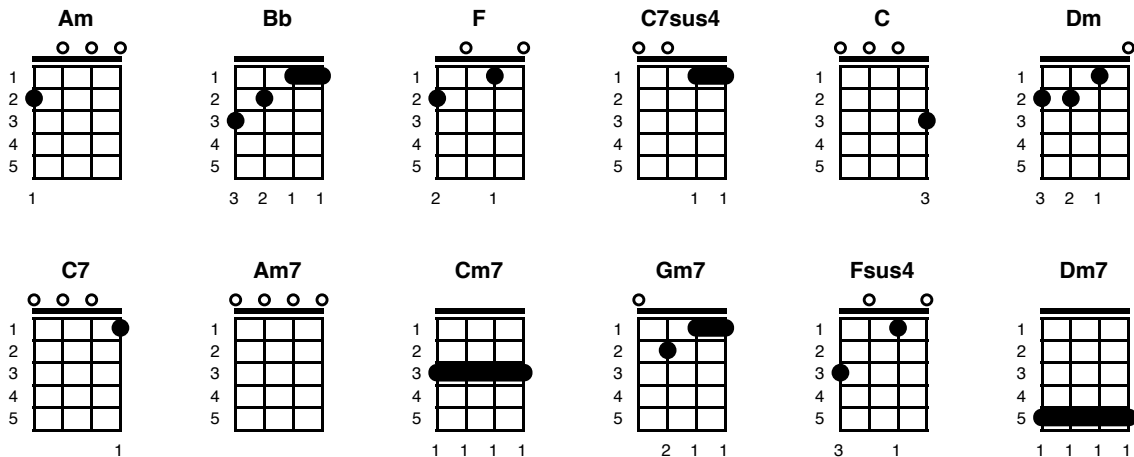


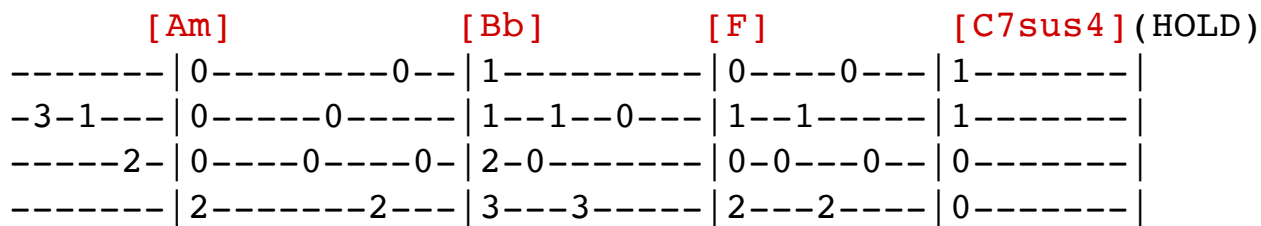
The Water Is Wide
