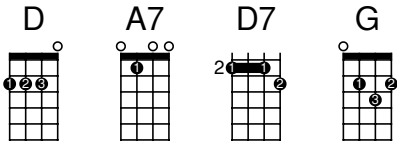


Blues, Stay Away from Me
