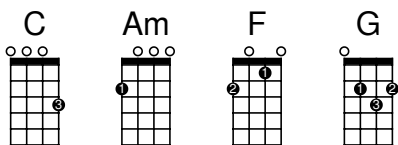


Heart and Soul
