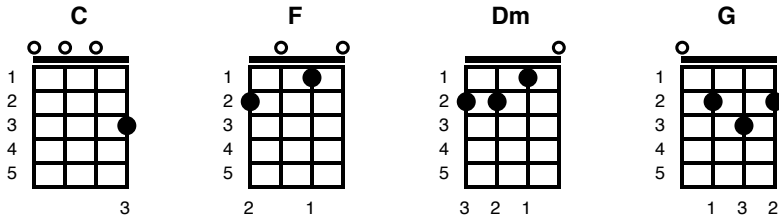


Let the Light in
