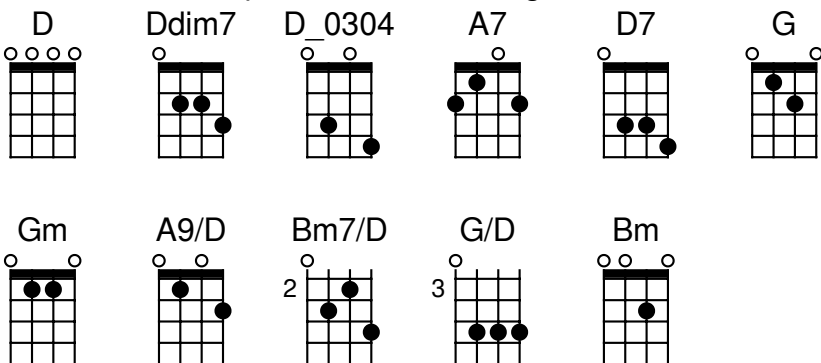


# It Don't Worry Me (Revisited)
