## Normal Speed

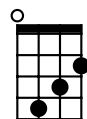
[Em] He gave her his townhouse and his racing horses

[Em] Hi-de-hi-de-hi-de-ho! (Hi-de-hi-de-hi-de-ho!)

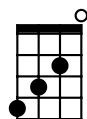
## Slow - single strums
