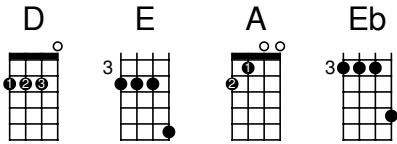


I Fall to Pieces

Intro

[D] [E] [A] (repeat)
