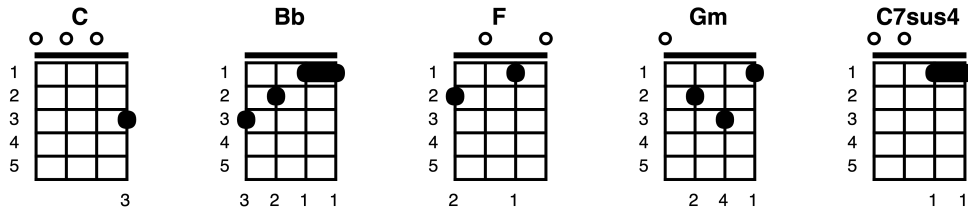


I Have a Good Day Every Now and Then
