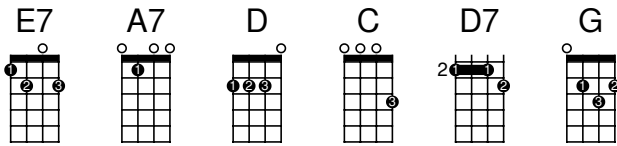


My Old Man
