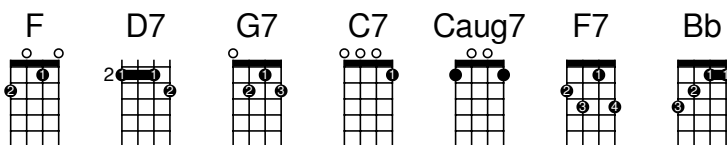


Where did Robinson Crusoe go with Friday on Saturday night?
