

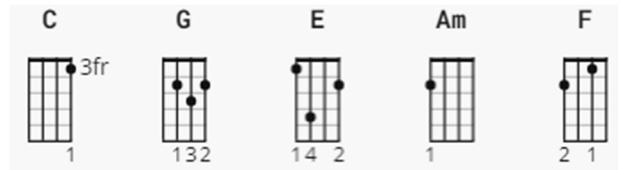
# GOING BACK HOME
