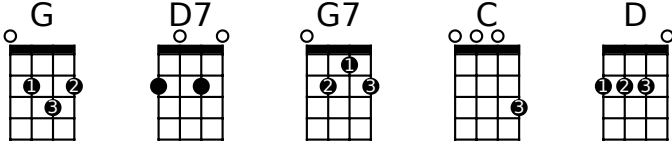


Old Lang's Sign
