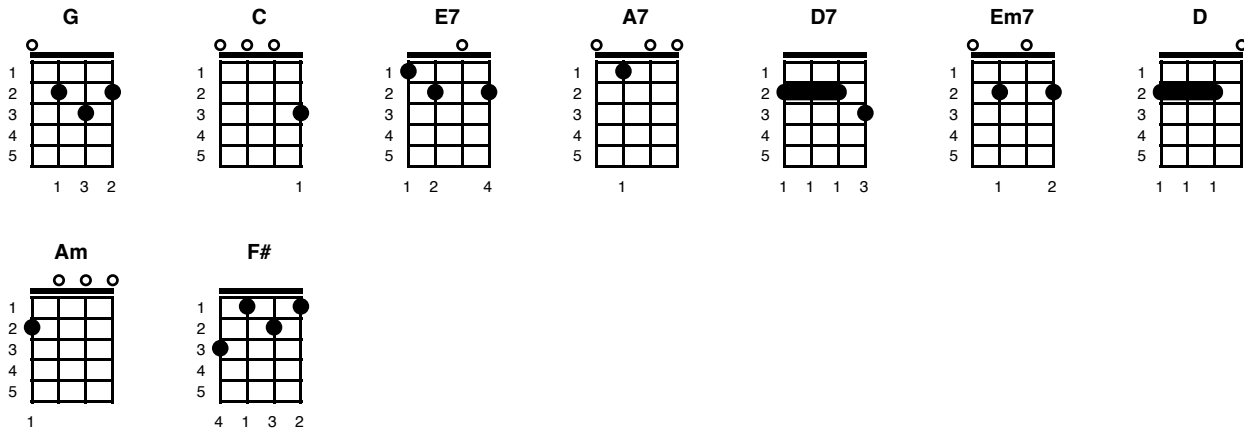


# Swinging on a Star
