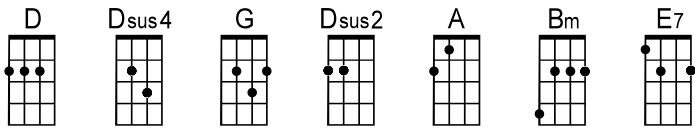


The Frozen Man: James Taylor
