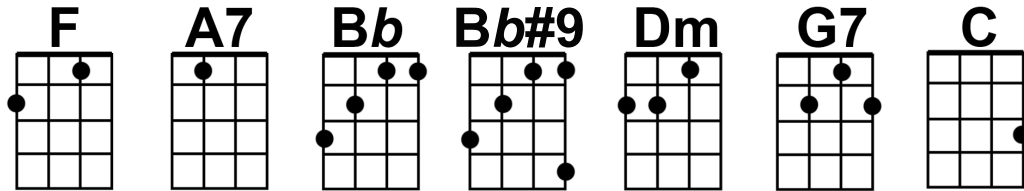


“I’M NOBODY’S CHILD” - Christine Rojek
