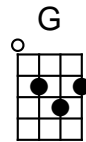
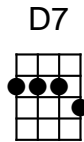
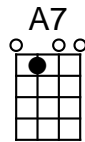
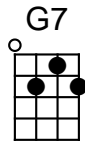
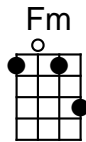
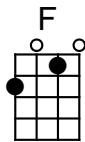
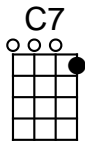
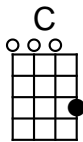


Tonight You Belong to Me
