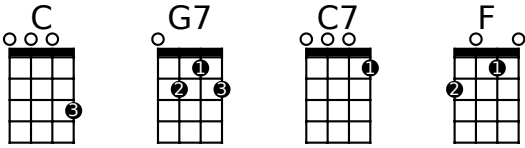


Mess of Blues
