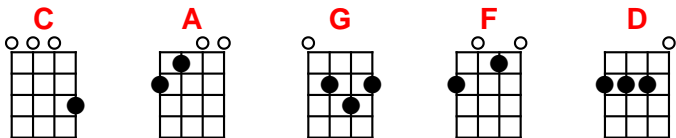


# IN THE MIDNIGHT HOUR
