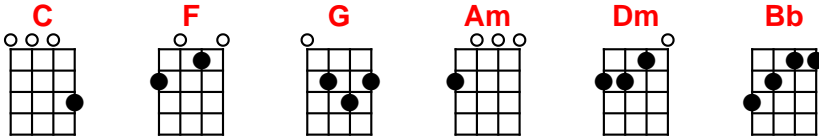


Railroad Town Without A Train
