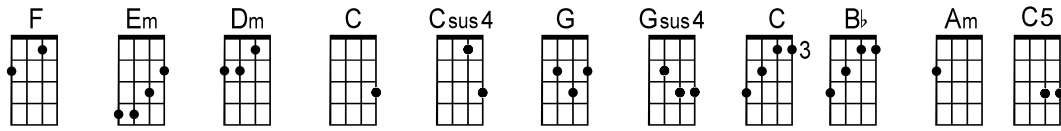


Queen Jane Approximately by Bob Dylan
